KINETIC MUSCLES AND COLUMBIA SCIENTIFIC SIGN DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

Tempe, AZ and Portland, OR – September 22, 2006 – Kinetic Muscles, Inc. (KMI) and Columbia Scientific, LLC jointly announced a distribution agreement today. Effective immediately, Columbia Scientific is the exclusive distributor of KMI's Hand Mentor Pro™ rehabilitation device in the United States. The Hand Mentor Pro™ is specifically designed for rehabilitation of the hand and wrist in people who have suffered strokes or other brain injuries. This device is the first in a line of KMI products that will address the entire side of the body affected by a stroke.
